Inter-University PhD in Educational Studies Portfolio In-Progress Assessment Form

Normally, throughout the first four semesters of their program (July-June), doctoral students will assemble a scholarly portfolio, prepared in negotiation with their Supervisor and under the auspices of their Supervisory Committee. They can submit at the end of the first year, and must submit by the end of their second year, their Portfolio for examination by their Supervisory Committee and an External Examiner before undertaking their Proposal and Dissertation. The Supervisor has already filed with the IDAC an *Initial Portfolio Agreement* form at the end of April of the first year of study (which included the doctoral student's initial draft of the narrative). The initial form attested to the doctoral student's agreement to compile specific elements of the portfolio. To maintain relevancy and rigour, both the doctoral student and the Supervisor (and the committee members if deemed appropriate by the Supervisor) also will complete and sign this in-progress (formative) assessment of the progress being made on the portfolio. This assessment will: (a) confirm the providence (originality) of each artifact and (b) help everyone come to an agreement about the degree of progress to date.
